

RESOLVED by the town Council of the Town of Digby that the following by-law be enacted and that the Clerk forward three copies of it, duly certified and sealed, to the Minister of Municipal Affairs for his approval thereof.

**BY-LAW #1989-02**

**A BY-LAW TO CLOSE A PORTION OF CARLETON STREET**

1. **THAT** the Council does close to public use a portion of the street known as Carleton Street.
2. **THAT** the portion of the said street hereby closed to public use pursuant to Section 1 of this By-Law is as follows:  
  
**ALL** that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the Town of Digby, County of Digby and Province of Nova Scotia and being a portion of Carleton Street lying east of Maiden Lane.  
  
**BEING AND INTENDED TO BE** the portion of Carleton Street lying from the East Side of Maiden Lane to original low water mark as detailed in the Year of Our Lord 1783 A.D.
3. **THAT** the portion of Carleton Street as described in Section 2 of this by-law be closed and that all rights of public user heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the Town may sell and convey the portion so closed.
