The Town Of Digby is looking for designs for Banners located on the Promenade on Water Street in Digby and Fishermen's Park on Maiden Lane in Digby.

The contest will be open to Grade 3, 4, 5 & 6 Students that attend Digby Elementary School, Digby Neck Consolidated and Island Consolidated.

There will be 11 designs chosen to be displayed on the promenade, 4 chosen to be displayed at Fishermen's Park and 2 on Prince William Street heading towards Fishermen's Park. These 17 banners will be displayed during the tourist season.

We want our children to be able to tell us what their community and their everyday life means to them. The design is entirely up to the young artist. It could be something about the area they live in, a favorite past time, a favorite cartoon character or display a thank you to the personal that is helping us through the Covid-19 pandemic.

- New original artwork must be created
- Paper size 8.5 x 11 inches
- Artwork will be selected by a selections panel
- The successful applicants will be notified by phone
- The dead line for submissions will be **May 15, 2020**
